Description: As technical team lead he worked closely with the project/account managers and his responsibilities encompassed client liaising, requirement gathering, project scoping, producing technical documentation, designing/architecting of solutions with hands on coding/implementation of the solutions at the core of his role.

- Mentoring the other team members, assigning/reviewing work, guiding them in the implementation phase to ensure adherence to the technical specifications and delivering the projects on time and on budget was a crucial part of his work, as was managing day to day maintenance and change requests of the site.
- The role also included line management duties such as twice yearly reviews/assessments; identifying training needs etc, as well as interviewing new candidates for developer/front-end/tester roles within the company.
